#### ME AND THE OTHERS

Grammar: verb to be (all forms) – subject pronouns – possessive adjectives and pronouns – indefinite articles – plurals – demonstrative adjectives – possessive case – question words – numbers – the alphabet there is/there are – definite articles – verb have got (all forms) – plural irregular nouns – prepositions of time – ordinal numbers.

Vocabulary: everyday objects, classroom objects, countries and nationalities, jobs, family, school places and subjects, days of the week, months and seasons.

Functions: asking for and giving personal information, meeting people, telling the time, telling the date

#### EVERYDAY LIFE

Grammar: Present simple - love, like, don't mind, hate+ing form - object pronouns – question words – adverbs of frequency – prepositions of time and place – prepositions of movement - imperative.

Vocabulary: free time activities, daily routines, places in town, transport.

Functions : talking about daily routines, likes and dislikes, expressing agree and disagree, asking for and giving directions

#### DAILY HABITS

Grammar: countable and uncountable nouns - indefinite adjectives and adverbs - time sequencers - can for ability, permission and requests - degrees of ability - modifiers.

Vocabulary: food and drink, portions and containers, currencies and prices, sports, make and do

Functions: offering and making request, ordering food, making and rejecting suggestions

#### DESCRIBING PEOPLE AND PLACES

Grammar: to be/have got + physical characteristics, present continuous, present simple vs present continuous, comparative and superlative adjectives

Vocabulary: appearance, personality adjectives, houses, things in a house

Functions: describing people and places, talking about distance
